Juror Anne-Marie Kornachuk



Anne-Marie Kornachuk (Canadian born 1969 in Pin Court Quebec) is an internationally renowned realist painter, best known for her paintings of women surrounded by reams of fabric and her full size portraits of horses made to exact scale. Anne-Marie works with oil and traditional painting techniques. She is influenced by the theatricality of Baroque Art.

The animated nature of fabric speaks to her about the hidden drama of the women she paints while the massive size, beauty and expressiveness of her equestrian subjects speak in poetic terms about emotion and experience. She meets every horse she paints to take their measurements and understand their unique personality.

Anne-Marie completed her BFA at Concordia University in Montreal in 1993. Since graduation she has participated in numerous solo and group exhibitions in Canada, The United States and abroad. Most recently in 2017 she was won the Director's Choice Award, International Guild of Realism Winter Salon Exhibition at the Marshall Gallery in Scottsdale, Arizona. She is represent by galleries both in Canada and the U.S.

She lives in Lakefield, Ontario with her husband and is an avid equestrian herself, a dedicated student of dressage and much of her free time is spent training and having fun with her horse. AWARDS:
